MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE METROPOLITAN SCHOOL DISTRICT OF NORTH POSEY COUNTY, INDIANA

HELD AUGUST 12, 1993

The regular meeting of the Board of Education of the M.S.D. of North Posey County, Indiana, was held in the office of the Superintendent of Schools on the 12th day of August, 1993, at the hour of 5:30 P.M., with Board Members Saxe, Buecher, Lewis, Baehl, and Schmitt present. Also attending were Superintendent Brenton and Administrative Assistant Rapp.

At 5:30 P.M. it was the decision of the Board to go into an Executive Session to discuss land acquisition adjacent to North Posey High School. The Board secured from Executive Session at 6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by President Saxe, who presided. Minutes of the previous meetings of July 12 and July 26, 1993 were read to the Board and approved as read.

Claims

A copy of the Claim Docket was presented to the Board for their consideration and upon a motion made by Buecher, seconded by Baehl, and unanimously carried, the Claim Docket was approved by the Board. A copy of the approved Claim Docket shall be made a part of the minutes by incorporation.

Public Law 240-1991- Capital Projects Resolution

On a motion made by Schmitt, seconded by Buecher, and unanimously carried, the Board approved a Resolution which will allow a portion of the M.S.D. of North Posey County's Capital Projects Fund tax levy to be used to pay actual increases in health care costs for corporation employees that occur after July 1, 1993 for coverage in effect on or before January, 1993. A copy of the Resolution shall be made a part of the minutes by incorporation.

School Bus Safety Inspection

Mr. Rapp reported to the Board that the district had it's best bus inspection over the past 17 years as none of the district's 31 buses and two 15 passenger vans failed to pass inspection by the Indiana State Police on August 10, 1993. Mr. Rapp further reported that yellow reflective tape to improve visibility at night had been installed on ten of the corporation buses that are used during evening hours for extra curricular trips.

Teacher Recommendations

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, on a motion made by Buecher, seconded by Schmitt and unanimouly carried, the Board approved the following:

Marilyn Rogers - full time teaching position, increasing schedule from 4 to 6 physical science classes

Janet Spahn - full time teaching position at the 6th grade level at North Elementary

Rebecca Coleman - half-time teacher assistant, to assist Donna Nash with her pre-school students.

Chapter I Parent Meeting

Mr. Rapp read a letter to the Board from Doris Williams, Chapter I Coordinator, inviting the Board members to attend a South Terrace elementary Chapter I parents meeting at 9:00 A.M. on September 1, 1993

Larry Schmitt - North Posey Baseball Booster Club, Inc

Larry Schmitt, secretary of the newly organized North Posey Baseball Booster Club, Inc was present to inform the Board of the newly formed organization and outline the goals they had established for their organization to support the North Posey baseball program. He requested permission from the Board the authority to begin til—the diamond and hauling in about 20 loads of fill dirt for the infield, with the work to begin on Saturday, August 28, 1993. He further explained they would like to sow grass in order to have a grass infield in time for the 1994 baseball season.

Board Minutes August 26, 1993

Mr. Schmitt also requested permission for the Booster Club to sell advertising signs which would be installed on the outfield fence during the baseball season. The revenue from the sale of the signs to various vendors would be used to cover the cost of the improvements outlined above, with the remaining revenue to go into the treasury of the North Posey High School athletic department.

Following a discussion, it was the Board's decision to delay approval for the installation of the signs until the next regularly scheduled meeting on September 13, 1993, when a full board would be present. The board gave their approval to Mr. Schmitt to go ahead with the tiling of the diamond and the hauling of the dirt to raise the infield playing area.

As there was no further school business to come before the board at this time the meeting was adjourned at 6:50 P.M.
