

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE METROPOLITAN  
SCHOOL DISTRICT OF NORTH POSEY COUNTY, INDIANA

Held June 8, 1970

The regular meeting of the Board of Education of the Metropolitan School District of North Posey County, Indiana, was held in the office of the Superintendent of Schools on the 8th day of June, 1970, at the hour of 5:30 p. m. , with Board Members Hall, Fletchall, Staples, Wade and Tenison present. Also attending were Superintendent Hollen, Administrative Assistant William Wilson, Attorney Schuler, and board member elect, Kenneth Eisterhold.

The meeting was called to order by President Hall, who presided. Minutes of the previous meeting of May 25 were read to the Board and approved as read.

Claims No. 712 through No. 735 in the amount of \$2,220.40 were presented to the Board, and after due consideration, upon motion by Wade, seconded by Staples and unanimously carried, were ordered paid.

Bids for gasoline, fuel oil and coal were received and ordered taken under advisement by the Board for study and probable action at the next Board meeting.

A request was received from Phillip Schmidt to be permitted to attend college on work toward his masters' degree from June 22 to August 8, with the first two weeks being considered as earned vacation and the remaining five weeks to be under a leave of absence without pay. Permission was granted by the Board. The superintendent announced it would be necessary to employ a substitute teacher for two weeks for supervision at the county fair and at an agricultural camp meeting at Lincoln State Park, and upon motion by Staples, seconded by Tenison, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the employment of Glen Bender as a substitute teacher to be paid at the rate of \$25.00 per day.

The superintendent reported to the Board that vacancies remaining were for an elementary principal, a vocal music teacher, and business teacher at the high school, and a kindergarten and sixth grade teacher in the elementary schools.


The superintendent reported on a meeting with the custodians, and following an extended discussion, the superintendent and administrative assistant were directed to present the Board with a recommendation at the next board meeting.


The superintendent reported on coaching assignments in the district, and indicated that although most were filled, it was yet necessary to select individuals to fill a few posts.

The Board met with the salary committee of the North Posey Classroom Teachers' Association, and after extended discussions and negotiation, proposed a salary schedule, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part of these minutes by incorporation. Mr. Lee Riggs, chairman of the committee, indicated that the schedule would be submitted to the teachers for their vote and a report made to the Board as soon as possible.

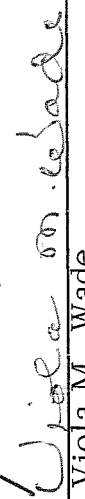
Following a discussion of other school matters, on motion made, seconded and unanimously carried, the meeting adjourned at 10:30 p. m.

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE METROPOLITAN  
SCHOOL DISTRICT OF NORTH POSEY COUNTY, INDIANA

Held June 22, 1970

The regular meeting of the Board of Education of the Metropolitan School District of North Posey County, Indiana, was held in the office of the Superintendent of Schools on the 22nd day of June, 1970 at the hour of 7:30 p. m., with Board Members Hall, Fletchall, Staples, Wade and Tenison present. Also attending were Superintendent Hollen, Attorney Schuler, and Board Member-elect, Kenneth Eisterhold.

The meeting was called to order by President Hall, who presided. Minutes of the previous meeting of June 8 were read to the Board and approved as read.

Claims No. 736 through No. 765 totaling \$3,971.77 were presented to the Board, and upon motion duly made by Wade, seconded by Fletchall, and unanimously carried, were approved by the Board and ordered paid.

Mr. Henry Meier and Mr. Joseph Blankenberger of the Posey County Taxpayers Association met with the Board to discuss matters relative to the burden imposed upon real estate by the educational system, and to urge the Board to cooperate and assist in an effort to secure a revision of the state tax structure in order to secure greater state aid for local education.

The superintendent reported the receipt of a letter from Mr. Lee Riggs indicating that the North Posey Classroom Teachers' Association had voted 34 to 11 to accept the salary proposal and expressing his appreciation to the Board for their conduct and cooperation in the negotiations.

The superintendent further reported the hiring of Mrs. Bobbie Pfafflin as business teacher in the high school, and the resignation of Mr. John Becking, and reported on other vacancies in the teaching system.

Mr. Hollen reported that Mr. Helm had started a recreation basketball program on June 15; that Mr. Ronald Scherer had resigned as bus driver; that investigations were being made to determine what type of fuel might be used at the Jr-Sr high school since it was no longer possible to secure No. 5 Fuel Oil, which is currently being used; that Miss Cathi Cartwright had been employed at the high school under a state work study program - with the local district paying 26 cents per hour of her salary.

A request was received by the Chamber of Commerce to use kitchen facilities and a section of bleachers for the Fourth of July horse show, which was granted.

The superintendent reported a schedule of salaries for non-instructional personnel, including custodians, clerks, and the administrative staff. After discussion, on motion made by Wade, seconded by Staples and unanimously carried, the Board adopted these schedules, with amendments, and a copy of such schedules are attached hereto and made a part of these minutes by incorporation.

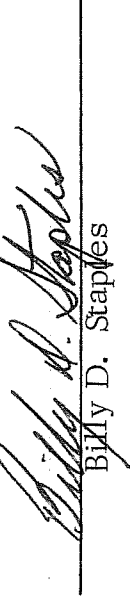
Mr. Fletchall reported that the Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90, 000) of General Obligation Funds invested in Government Bonds had matured, and with the approval of the Board, the money would be re-invested for an additional six-month period.

There being no further business to come before the Board, on motion made and seconded, the meeting adjourned at the hour of 11:45 p. m.

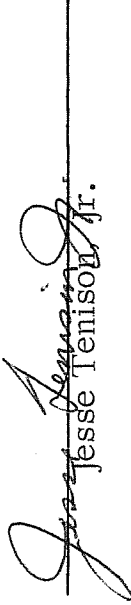
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
