MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE METROPOLITAN SCHOOL DISTRICT OF NORTH POSEY COUNTY, INDIANA

Held June 26, 1978

The regular meeting of the Board of Education of the Metropolitan School District of North Posey County, Indiana, was held in the office of the Superintendent of Schools on the 26th day of June, 1978, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m., with Board Members Eisterhold, Newman, Hall, Staples, and Tenison present. Also attending were Superintendent Brenton, Administrative Assistant Rapp and Attorney Johnson.

The meeting was called to order by President Eisterhold who presided. Minutes of the previous meeting of June 12, 1978, were read to the Board and approved as read.

Claims

Claims No. 518-551 in the amount of \$ 3,938.41 were presented to the Board for consideration, and upon motion duly made by Hall, seconded by Newman and unanimously carried were approved by the Board and ordered paid.

Roofing Update

Mr. Brenton informed the Board that Ted Ellis of K/M Associates was in the process of gathering the necessary information completing the roofing specifications for the gymnasium at the High School at the South Terrace Elementary. The Superintendent informed the Board he would have more detailed information to present to the Board at their next regularly scheduled meeting.

Teacher Recommendations

Mr. Brenton recommended to the Board the employment of Charles Wempe as Agriculture teacher, John Elliott as Social Studies teacher and assistant football coach. Upon Motion duly made by Hall, seconded by Staples and unanimously carried the Board accepted Mr. Brenton's recommendation.

Summer Maintenance

Mr. Brenton reported to the Board that Robert Smith and the custodial staff were in the process of painting and cleaning the floors in the various buildings throughout the district. It was further reported to the Board that it would be necessary to bury a new water line from the rear of the High School out to the athletic fields due to the poor condition of the present water line to the athletic fields.

South Terrace Sanitation System

The Superintendent informed the Board that Mt. Vernon Electric had completed the installation of the lift pumps for the sanitation system at the South Terrace Elementary and that the plant was working smoothly.

Summer School

The Board was informed by the Superintendent about the progress of the Summer School program thus far. Mr. Brenton informed the Board that he had received many favorable comments on the girls gymnastic program under the instruction of Cherri Schnautz.
