

COLLEGE VISITS

April 30 Deadline

College Campus Visits

- Seniors are allowed two campus visits and must be taken by April 30.
- Juniors are allowed one campus visit and must be taken by April 30.
- Arrange an appointment by contacting the admissions office at the college.
- Students must provide their counselor with written notification from a parent stating the college, time, and date of a visit AT LEAST 3 SCHOOL DAYS IN ADVANCE of the visit.
- Get a blue slip from your counselor to take with you for a college representative to sign.
- Return the signed slip to your counselor the day after the visit.
- Failure to return the blue slip could result in an unexcused absence.
- These days will not count against the final exam exemption policy provided the above steps are followed.

Post-Secondary Information

Trip To College Text Alerts are available for students in grades 7-12. Each month, the Indiana Youth Institute sends three to four grade-specific messages with helpful tips, reminders and resources that will help youth prepare for postsecondary education. We encourage adults and students to sign up and follow along with the messages. Just text "grad" plus a student's graduation year to 69979 (ex: grad2022). Messages can serve as great discussion starters, research assignments or writing prompts.

Transcripts: Transcripts from North Posey High School are sent electronically through Parchment. All you have to do is look for the Transcript Requests link under the Guidance Department on the North Posey web site www.northposey.k12.in.us and create an account. The state of Indiana will cover the cost for all electronic transcripts delivered to all colleges and the NCAA Eligibility Center for free for current high school students. You'll get an email when each transcript is sent, and for colleges that accept transcripts electronically, when they receive it as well. If you need a transcript for a scholarship, insurance discount, employment, or any other reason, please come to the Guidance Office and request it.

Ivy Tech's Associate Accelerated Program (ASAP): As you are planning for your future, consider this program offered at Ivy Tech that allows students to earn a two-year associates degree in just one year. Visit www.ivytech.edu/asap for more information.

21st Century Scholars: Visit the 21st Century Scholars website for a comprehensive resource for parents and students. You'll find tools and materials to help guide scholars in completing the necessary requirements and earning their scholarships. Visit <https://secure.in.gov/apps/che/scholartrack/>

SAT/ACT Information: It is recommended for juniors who are planning to attend college to take the SAT and/or the ACT at least once by the end of their junior year. To register visit <http://sat.collegeboard.org/> for the SAT. To register for the ACT, visit www.actstudent.org. It's important to plan for these exams in advance because they are only offered on Saturday mornings October through June one time per month. Several colleges have early deadlines for admission and scholarship consideration.
