



Our Vision:

Our Vision is to be one of the best small (Main Street) towns in Indiana, and a commercial hub for the surrounding area.

Who we are:

We are a group of businesses, organizations, and residents with a stake in the long-term prosperity of Poseyville and the surrounding area.

What we do:

We promote growth and overall quality of place through our three primary initiatives:

- Main Street "Heart of Poseyville"
- Housing
- Promotion of the town

Why we exist:

We exist to help promote the prosperity of Poseyville for current and future generations. We invest in projects and initiatives that directly promote growth and improve quality of place.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: I already pay taxes, why should I support Grow Posevyille?

A: We are not a government entity. We are a volunteer led **<u>nonprofit</u>**. We are not bound by the same regulations as the government, therefore we can invest in a wider range of opportunities to enhance our town.

Q: What is the difference between Grow Poseyville and Heart of Poseyville?

A: These are sister entities developed to satisfy state requirements for ODAN Indiana Main Street status. Grow Poseyville is the broad organization focused on the overall town and surrounding area. Heart of Poseyville is focused specifically on Main Street. All donated funds are raised through Grow Poseyville and may be diverted to Heart of Poseyville when warranted. Heart of Poseyville generates income through various fundraising events such as "Meal on Main".

Q: Are the board members paid?

A: No, this is a volunteer led organization. In fact, each board member is expected to make a minimum donation to the organization. We do not use organization funds for our meetings, meals, etc...

Q: What have you done with the money?

A: The short answer is, so far, not a lot. We want to be prudent with the resources, and invest in the right opportunities when needed. We are actively seeking input from the community on these opportunities. To date, 100% of the donations have stayed within the organization or have gone directly to expenses related to projects or donations. 78% of the funds raised are still in the bank waiting to be deployed.

Q: Does this organization only benefit the businesses in town?

A: No, we invest in projects and initiatives that directly promote growth and improve the quality of place for all. We hope every resident and stakeholder in the community sees an impact. As our businesses are the economic engine for the community, they will inevitably benefit from this organization. We want/need our business to thrive here so they stay here. We also need a population to support the local businesses, which is why we are investing in housing. We also support and collaborate with other non profit organizations in the area. A rising tide lifts all ships.

Q: Is Grow Poseyville the investor in the newly proposed subdivision(s)?

A: No, Grow Poseyville is providing time, talent, and minimal financial support for the preliminary planning phases of this project. Grow Poseyville is the conduit between the land owners, potential investors/developers, and local government to make this project a reality.
