If you wish to give consent, please complete and sign this Parent Consent Form. Peer to Peer Leader applications that are not accompanied by a properly signed and completed Parent Consent Form will not be accepted by Peer to Peer Leadership, Inc. Students who are 18 years of age or older may complete and sign the Consent Form themselves.

By signing this form, I am giving the Peer to Peer staff permission to communicate with the staff and administrators of my student's school regarding services offered to my student by either entity. In addition, by signing this form, I am authorizing the exchange of documents and information between Peer to Peer Leadership and my student's school, which is specifically defined below. I understand that all records and information regarding services is protected by the Family Educational Rights Privacy Act, which governs the exchange of confidential information.

In the event Peer to Peer Leadership requires an additional license after expiration of this authorization, the organization will seek an additional release from the individual.
